- 1. <u>League</u>: A nine game season will be provided for Divisions "A-D". The season concludes on **April 6, 2024,** for all divisions.
- 2. <u>Coaches</u>: We are always in need of coaches! Experience is not necessary but does help. A manual and coaching clinic can be provided for new coaches. If you are interested in coaching, please contact 626-569-2256 to fill out a volunteer application. If not enough coaches volunteer in your child's division, some players will not be able to participate and will be refunded accordingly (last participants to register).
- 3. <u>Player Evaluations:</u> This is <u>mandatory</u> for <u>all</u> players. Player evaluations are vital to our organization as we attempt to provide equally balanced teams. These are <u>not</u> tryouts and everyone who registers will play. The player evaluations will be conducted on Saturday, January 6, 2024 at Garvey Park Gym 7954 Dorothy St. Please check-in at your assigned times.

- **5.** <u>Practices</u>: All practices will begin the <u>week of January 22</u>. Each team is limited to two practices per week and a maximum of one hour in duration. The practice site and time will be left up to the volunteer coach. There is no guarantee to what area of Rosemead your child's practice site will be located. Our first priority is to place children on teams according to their rating. It is the sole responsibility of the parent to provide transportation for their child to and from practices and games.
- **6.** <u>Games:</u> All Games will begin <u>Saturday</u>, <u>February 3.</u> A detailed game schedule will be provided the second week of practice.
