- 1. <u>League</u>: A nine (9) game season will be provided for Divisions "A-D". The season concludes on June 3rd for all divisions.
- 2. <u>Volunteer Coaches</u>: We are always in need of coaches! Experience is not necessary but does help. A manual and coaching clinic will be provided for new coaches upon request. If you are interested in coaching, please contact (626) 569-2264 to fill out a volunteer application. If not enough coaches volunteer in your child's division, some players will not be able to participate and will be refunded accordingly (last participant's to register).
- 3. <u>Player Evaluations:</u> This is <u>mandatory</u> for <u>all</u> players. Player evaluations are vital to our organization as we attempt to provide equally balanced teams. These are <u>not</u> tryouts and everyone who registers will play. The player evaluations will be conducted on <u>Friday, March 22nd at Garvey Park Gym 7954 Dorothy St.</u> Please check-in at your assigned times.

- 6-8 yrs. old (Div. D) = 5:30 p.m.
- 9-10 yrs. old (Div. C) = 6:30 p.m.
- 11-14 yrs. old (Div. A B) = 7:30 p.m.

- 4. <u>Meet and Greet:</u> The Meet and Greet event is a chance for participants to meet their team and coach. The Meet and Greet will be held on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>April 13th</u>, at the <u>Rosemead Community Recreation Center 3636 Muscatel Ave.</u> Please arrive at your scheduled time:
 - 6-14 yrs. old (Div. A-D) = 9:00 a.m.
- **5.** <u>Practices</u>: All practices will begin the <u>week of April 15th</u>. Each team is limited to two practices per week and a maximum of one hour in duration. The practice site and time will be left up to the volunteer coach, but are usually held Monday & Wednesday or Tuesdays and Thursdays after 5:30pm.

6. <u>Games:</u> Will begin the <u>Saturday</u>, <u>April 27th.</u> A detailed game schedule will be provided the second week of practice.
